Assignment #1

You will be required to complete a Summer Book Report form for **one** of the books that you read. You may write in print or cursive. The book reports will be due by Friday, August 11th. You will receive an **English grade** for your book report. We will be grading on the following:

- complete sentences
- capitalization
- punctuation
- spelling
- content
- neatness

Ten points will be taken off each day for late work after August 11th.

Assignment #2

You need to have 3 objects that tell about or describe one of the books you read. It **cannot** be the same one you do the written report on. The objects need to be put in a small brown or white paper bag and brought to school by Friday, August 11th. Be sure to put your name and the book title on the bag.

Assignment #3

You will be required to take an A.R. test by the end of the first week of school on Friday, August 11th on the **three** books read. Students will receive one reading grade from the average of all 3 A.R. tests.
